Senator Kennedy has served as a Receiver and as a Bankruptcy Trustee in matters with assets and interests around the State of Georgia, outside of Georgia and internationally.

He has served as President of the Macon Bar Association (2009-2010) and is a member of the Board of Governors for the State Bar of Georgia (2009-current). Senator Kennedy is also a Class of 2000 Graduate of Leadership Macon and a 2007 Graduate of Leadership Georgia. Senator Kennedy was appointed in 2013 by Georgia House of Representatives, Speaker of the House David Ralston to the Immigration Enforcement Review Board. In 2014, Senator Kennedy was invited and appointed to the Mercer University Walter F. George School of Law Board of Visitors. In 2015, Senator Kennedy was named Freshman Legislator of the Year by the Georgia Chamber of Commerce. In 2017 Senator Kennedy was recognized by James Magazine as Legislator of the Year.
